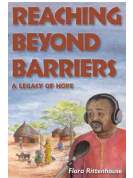

## TEN PRAYER REQUESTS:

**Staffing Needs.** There is an immediate and urgent need for a Broadcast Engineer and a Mechanic & Maintenance Person. Pray that God would provide the right people at the right time.

**Support is Low.** Due to the extra expenses of RVA, our support level is low. Please pray that God would provide. If you feel God leading you in this area, see below for how you can get involved.

**Shortwave License.** TWR has applied to the Benin government for a shortwave license. Currently, TWR is waiting on response from government authorities. Some concerns exist regarding details of the license to ensure needed flexibility for shortwave broadcasts

**NGO Status.** TWR has presented a request to the government of Benin for NGO status. This status will give TWR key tax advantages. The process is not as quick or straightforward as one would hope.

**Cox Children.** Missionary life does not just involve the parents. Pray for Nehemiah, Micah Joy and Miriam as they also live out the Gospel while in school (Nehemiah and Micah Joy in Kenya at RVA, and Miriam being homeschooled in Benin.)

**Title Deed for Parakou Housing/Office.** TWR has purchased property in Parakou to build missionary housing and an office. This process is in the beginning stages of a long process, nine months minimum. We are still waiting on some official notifications to be made public so we can proceed to the next stage.

**2011 Mission Trip.** We are hoping and praying that there will be a mission's trip to Benin in 2011. Pray for God's leading and direction.

**Health.** While there was a marked improvement in health this past year, we still live in a malaria, typhoid, yellow fever and meningitis zone with limited medical access.

**Wisdom on Responding to the Spiritual Darkness and Wickedness.** In addition to the normal darkness from influences of other major world religions, fetishes outside our door and the talismans we pass; this past year there have been cases of child slavery and ritual sacrifice of children in our neighborhood. Pray for protection, wisdom and God-empowered responses to these issues. Also, pray for the local police as they work toward justice.

**Ministry.** In addition to our ministry with TWR, please pray for us as we daily try to minister to those around us through activities such as Kids' Club, church, relationships with our neighbors, and a weekly dinner for expat singles.
