

<b>PASSION</b>	The 255 million unevangelized in Africa, the lack of discipleship and lack of sound biblical teaching in the African church that prevents it from reaching the unevangelized and from taking a prominent place in global Christianity.	
<b>ETHOS</b>	For the glory of God to help the church produce Godly servant leaders by teaching, modeling and developing people through servant leadership and discipleship so that they grow in Christ like maturity while actively learning and intentionally teaching. Servant leadership and discipleship are spiritual arts and disciplines that require Spirit enabled love, humility, servitude, teachability, wisdom and sometimes toughness.	
<b>DISCIPLESHIP &amp; COUNSELING</b>	Guided people to grow in their faith through discipling and counseling. Discipleship includes helping colleagues (missionaries and nationals) and friends (Western and African) grow in their love for God, increase their hate for sin and resolve personal and interpersonal problems. Formal counseling situations include: infidelity, sexual abuse, paranoid schizophrenia, demon possession and domestic violence; to mention a few.	
<b>SPIRITUAL LEADERSHIP</b>	Led groups through teaching, preaching and experiential learning resulting in life changes and spiritual growth in a variety of situations. Experience includes fellowship groups, bible study groups, ministry focused teams, church services and conferences.	
<b>CROSS CULTURAL EXPERIENCE</b>	Developed a deep appreciation and understanding of cultural differences through living for over a year in five different countries and cultures (three of which are in Africa), which gives cultural orientation to discipling and teaching. Have led teams of national workers and missionaries to achieve strategic objectives in a second language that was learned later in life gaining valuable cross-cultural communication experience and sympathy for those who face language barriers.
